
Malaysia Law Scholarship

The Malaysia Law Scholarship is the most prestigious Law scholarship and is a full fee scholarship for 4 years duration. Applicants wishing to apply should use the application form attached.

Overview

The Malaysian Law Scholarship is generously funded by the College of Arts, Law and Education to encourage a high performing international student from Malaysia to study a Bachelor of Laws (Direct Entry) program, commencing in Semester 1, 2018. If you are planning to commence studies at the University of Tasmania's Bachelor of Laws (Direct Entry) program you must also apply for admission and have met the entry requirements for the program in order to be considered for this scholarship (for entry requirements see utas.edu.au/international/studying/courses2/law2/bachelor-of-laws-direct-entry-63p1). Students cannot be in receipt of any other tuition fee scholarship.

Eligibility

This scholarship is available to a Malaysian student commencing in the Bachelor of Laws (Direct Entry) degree program in Semester 1, 2018.

Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- is a Malaysian citizen;
- applies to study the Bachelor of Laws (Direct Entry) (63P1) degree program through an authorised representative agent of the University of Tasmania, commencing in Semester 1, 2018;
- has received and accepted an offer for the Bachelor of Laws (Direct Entry) (63P1), commencing Semester 1, 2018;
- has not previously undertaken any tertiary studies (excluding extension studies completed as part of a year 12 program or its equivalent); and
- is not applying for advanced standing/credit.

Ongoing Eligibility

To retain this award, recipients are required to remain enrolled fulltime (100% per year) in the Bachelor of Laws (Direct Entry) (63P1) and achieve a Credit (5.0/7.0) cumulative grade point average (CGPA) at the end of each academic year.

Value: Course Tuition Fees (approx A\$108,000 in total, which includes Student Services & Amenities Fees).

Duration: Four years

Closing date: October 31, 2017

Notification: Applicants will be notified in November if they have been selected for an interview. The successful interviewee will be notified of the decision in late November/early December.
